VICTIM HELP LIST

Items Lost Or Stolen?

We are required to report every pawn or purchase to the Sheriff's Investigations Department. Investigations will have, at their disposal, a total listing of each and every item, including the serial number and description. This is true of all pawn shops in our county.

As per state statute 539.003 (Confidentiality) we CANNOT and WILL NOT provide any information on any product or customer without a request from the Sheriff's Department. This state statute guarantees our customers' Rights to Privacy.

For your assistance, we suggest you do the following: Take this card, along with serial number(s) and description(s) of the item(s) lost or stolen, and report it to the Sheriff's substation where the incident occurred. Also provide them with a date and time of the loss or theft. Be aware it will take a minimum of three (3) days for the information to reach an investigator who will handle your case.

NOTE: All items purchased by the Pawn Shop are held for 30 days. All items pawned are held for 60 days. This allows Investigations ample time to recover items not rightfully owned by the person who did the transaction.

Due to Florida laws requiring customer ID and property reporting forms, less the 1/10 of 1% of items that go through a pawn shop are stolen property.
